CALL TO ORDER

President Kelly Bellafronte called the November 12, 2018 meeting to order at 6:37 p.m. and lead the Pledge of Allegiance. The November Agenda, October 2018 Minutes, and 2018 October Ledger were available.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Ally Zmuda moved to approve the October 2018 minutes and it was seconded. Nobody had anything to discuss and the motion carried.

PRINCIPAL REPORT

Matt Rowley reported they just added another chrome book cart for the 7th and 8th grade classrooms. The computer lab and classroom computers will all be removed within the next year because they are no longer able to be upgraded. We will be dependent on the chrome books. We will also start training with the staff on Edmentum which will replace Successmaker. Matt also reminded us that the Old Newsboys donations will be starting soon including at least a \$1 donation for a dress down day on December 7, 2018.

Amy Whaley further informed us that we currently have one chrome book cart for every grade level.

ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL REQUEST for FUNDS

Christine Coleman made a request for latex paint and mirrors for positive projects to be put into the Beverly School building.

Ally made a motion to approve funds up to \$150 for latex paint for a positive paint project in Beverly School bathrooms and it was seconded. Christine commented that TPS has already given the green light for parent volunteers and teacher to do the work. The motion carried.

Ally made a motion to approve funds up to \$150 for mirrors for a positive message mirror project throughout Beverly School and it was seconded. There was no discussion and the motion carried.

Ally made a motion to approve funds up to \$100 to help offset the cost of a Thanksgiving meal for two special ed classes and their parents on November 20, 2018 and it was seconded. Amy Lamberger stated she would like to see funds go to all the students and not just the minority of students. Kelly stated that the board would be open to discussing ideas for this. The motion carried.

Ally made a motion to approve up to \$80 for transportation to a Walleye game for 11 students and 1 administrator to utilize free suite tickets and it was seconded. There was no discussion and the motion carried.

PRESIDENT REPORT

Kelly reported that our science teacher Mr. Leonard was requesting funds to purchase microscopes for Beverly since they currently have to transport them back and forth from Bowsher. Jenni made a motion to approve the purchase 3 microscopes through the science funds and it was seconded. Janel suggested that we might be able to get something approved or donated through Elizabeth Buckholtz or Julie Campbell through our district science programs. The motion did not carry. We will first try to explore other avenues.
