PTO Meeting Minutes for Monday, March 12, 2012, 6:30 p.m.

The President called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Board Reports

Ways and Means Report:

- Marcos night on March 12th raised \$138.60; Mrs. Mowka's class won the pizza party.
- Waiting on the Bob Evans totals from March 28th.
- Market Day for March was \$112.54.

Secretary's Report

- Motion to approve minutes from March 2012, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report:

- Ledger ending balance \$25,090.20.

Vice Presidents Report:

- There will be a need for someone to take over the Juice Pouches. We sent out 9,600-10,000 pouches in March which we received \$0.02 each. We will need two to three people to handle the juice pouches and they need to be picked up 2-3 times a week. Pouches need to be sent in certain increments to receive funds. Principal's Report:

- Mrs. Daney ordered pencils and small water bottles for the kids to use during the OAA testing.
- OAA Testing begins on Tuesday, April 24th for grades 3-8
- Ohio passed House Bill 153 to assess teacher skills there are 6 different things in each district for the teachers to be assessed on their performance. This will be in place a year from June.
- Beverly has received some money from Brynedale from their activities fund which will be used to help pay for the bussing for field trips.
- Two musical events have been schedule for May. There will be a motivational drum line for grades 4-8 and also the Bowling Green Opera will be coming to perform for grades K-3 which is an anti-bulling program.
- Mrs. Frank is currently working on Field Day plans for May 25th which will include the entire school. More information will be coming home. There will also be a small luncheon for volunteers from throughout the school year.
- There will be a 2 hour delay on Wednesday, May 9th, which will be the last one for the school year.

President's Report:

- Kroger Community Rewards Program last quarter's check was \$623.00. **That is with only 50 families participating.** You need to re-enroll every April for Beverly to receive the rewards. Be sure to sign up or re-enroll this month. Go to www.krogercommunityrewards.com
- Carnival will be May 18th. If you have anything you would like to donate, unused gift cards, or new items, please send into office. Mrs. Daney and several classrooms are donating themed baskets to be either raffled off or put into the silent auction. Also, **tickets for raffle will be sold \$10 each or 3 for \$25.** Raffle for an iPad3 (which has been donated, valued at \$699) and a raffle for a hot air balloon experience (donated by Float-n-Air valued at \$700). Classroom selling the most tickets by May 15 will win a pizza or ice cream party.

- Girls Night Out is a Girl Scout fundraiser for the 100th anniversary of the Girl Scouts. The girls are going to Washington DC in June. - No uniform swap at Carnival this year. A possible date will be in early June for a uniform sale. See Ellen Woodruff for details.
- Friday, April 20th is a Sprit Day - Crazy Hair Day. Jeans are allowed with spirit wear or t-shirts. Please follow the dress code with no yoga pants. The 1st grade classes cannot participate in the Sprit Day as they will be on a field trip to the Theater.
- We exceeded our Campbell's soup labels goal and we are only about \$200 short on our box top goal. Help us reach our goal by turning in all Box Tops by May 18th.
- OAA testing is coming up; Mrs. Daney will be purchasing snacks for the class's grades 3-8. Looking for volunteers to help divided up snacks this Friday, April 20th in the morning. Please contact Debbie Collins or the office.
- Field trips, no parents are allowed to drive for field trips anymore. This is a TPS guideline it is in the TPS board documents. We will need to use buses for transportation, which will incur more costs for field trips. This has been in effect since October 2009. Mrs. Daney suggests, possibly appealing to the board and asking about changing this policy for the district. The cost of a bus is \$46 per hour and greater depending on the field trip. If we are unable to appeal this, we will need a plan in fall 2012, regarding field trips for next year and how they will be handled.
- We need to make an appeal to the TPS Board to have another full time secretary for the office. For every 400 students we receive one full time secretary. For every additional 100 students, the school receives a sub secretary 1 day per week. Parent volunteers help alleviate some of the things that Susan is unable to do. The high schools with fewer students than we have had more secretaries than what our office has. The more people we can get to contact the TPS board regarding this the better chance we have to change this policy.
