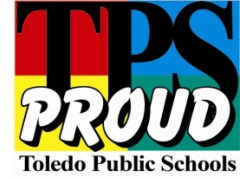

The Vice President called the meeting to order at 6:30pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Board Reports:

1. Secretary
 - Motion made to approve November 2013 meeting minutes, motion carried.
2. Treasurer
 - Motion made to approve November 2013 ledger, motion carried.
 - \$14,763.61 was the final profit for this year's Fun Walk.
 - Just under \$1,000 was earned at this year's Santa Shop.
3. Ways & Means
 - November's Marco's winner was Mr. Bucher's class & \$112.41 was earned.
 - Mr. Rowley approved the use of other colors in our school spirit wear, so be looking for new styles.
4. Vice President
 - The Beverly Scholarship: Two \$500 scholarships will be given to 2 Bowsher HS graduates. Criteria includes, matriculate of Beverly School, GPA, activities/involvement. A committee will review applicants & give the scholarships at the end of May.
