1. Secretary

New Business:

1. Request for funds
 - Mr. Bourland is requesting \$500-\$600 for a document camera for the science lab. Motion made to approve up to \$600 for a document camera for the science lab. Motion carried.

1. Outdoor Improvement Plan:
 - Old equipment has been moved.

Motion carried.

 - As of 10/31/14 funds raised = \$11,959.87.
 - Inflatable day is 12/12/14, cost = \$600.
 - Top 4 fundraisers and friends (each top fundraiser picks one friend) will have a bowling party on 11/25/14.
3. Santa Shop:
 - We have 15 registrations so far. Looking for more vendors (10-15 more). Tables are 8ft, \$20 for crafters, \$25 for direct sellers. Flyer to come home soon for volunteers.
4. Market Day:
 - Made our goal of 20 families. \$138.75 earned for October sales.
5. Athletics:
 - Breakfast with Santa on 12/14/14 at Max & Erma's in Maumee, can take your own photo, \$10/adult, \$5/kid (under 10y.o). 70% of ticket price goes to Athletics.
 - Basketball started practice, and 2nd session of soccer starts next week.
