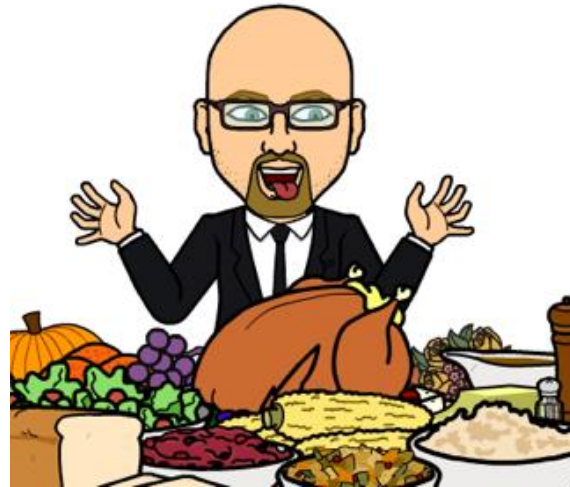

Nurses Notes

CARBON MONOXIDE POISONING AWARENESS

As home heating devices will be starting soon, please be aware of the following symptoms that may indicate a malfunctioning device, allowing carbon monoxide to collect in the home.

Carbon monoxide is a deadly, odorless gas that can be produced by cars, gas ranges/ovens, gas or kerosene space heaters, fireplaces and wood stoves. This gas can build up quickly without immediate detection.

The most common symptoms for carbon monoxide poisoning are headache, dizziness, confusion, and nausea and vomiting.

If you suspect any carbon monoxide collection in your home, evacuate all people and pets immediately and call “911”. The fire department will respond and assess the situation and provide further direction.
