### Facts About Snow and Snowflakes

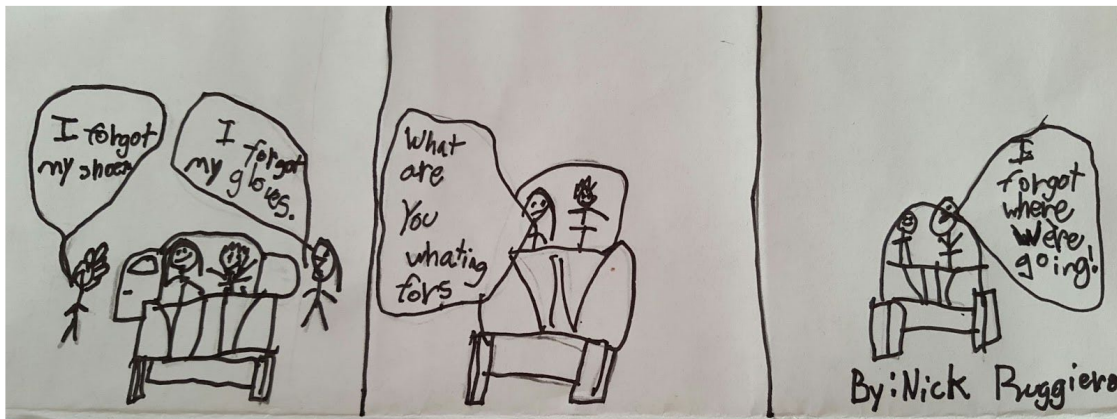
- To snow the temperature must be below 32 degrees Fahrenheit
